Taiwan has been playing a pioneering role in organ transplantation in Asia. Professor CJ Lee performed the first successful kidney transplantation in Asia in 1968. Later in 1984, Professor CL Chen performed the first successful liver transplantation and then then first pancreas transplantation in Asia, leading to the first legislation of brain death law in Asia. The Transplantation Society of Taiwan (TST) was established in 1985. TST not only devoted in the development of organ transplantations but also establish the multi-discipline linkage between immunology, infectious disease, pathology, pharmacology, physiology and nutrition. The COVID-19 pandemic had an impact to the deceased organ transplantations during these years. In the post-COVID pandemic era, transplant surgeons and physicians work extremely hard to carry organs to these who suffer from organ failure and make them reborn in the harsh circumstances.

The 2024 TST Spring Conference will be held in Kaohsiung conjoining with Taiwan Surgical Association (TSA) Annual Meeting. We invited Professor Björn

Nashanfor to give a special lecture about the role of mTOR inhibitor in liver transplantation and Professor YL Chen from Chung-Shan Medical University Hospital to give a talk about partial graft cadaveric liver transplantation for adult recipients.
